

Hill Country Community Action Association is a 501 C-3 organization that provides services to a nine county area in central Texas (Bell, Milam, Coryell, Lampasas, Mills, Hamilton, San Saba, Mason and Llano). HCCAA has a current annual budget of over \$17.5 million dollars and includes programs such as Head Start/Early Head Start, Senior Nutrition and Aging Services, Community Services Block Grant and Case Management Services, Energy Assistance, Weatherization, Low Income Water Assistance, Federal Rental Assistance (through Bell County), Child Care Services and Retired Senior Volunteer Program. Revenues for these programs are derived from Federal, State, and local grants. HCCAA employs over 200 people in the service area.
